Certifying boards




#### Accreditation

"GME programs are accredited when they are judged to be in substantial compliance with the Essentials of Accredited Residencies in Graduate Medical Education."








#### Structure of the ACGME

#### Board vs. Review Committees

- Board sets policy and direction
- Board is responsible for accreditation
- Board delegates authority to accredit programs/institutions to its Review Committees
- Board monitors Review Committees
- Board sets budget and fees



#### **Review Committees**

- Members are your peers
  - Specialists and subspecialists
- Six year terms, nominated by
  - ABMS Board
  - AMA and AOA
  - Specialty Society/College
- Resident physicians have two year term
  - From resident or PD societies
- Public non-MD member
- Approved by ACGME Board



#### **Review Committees**

- Meet 2-3 times a year
- Responsibilities
  - Program reviews
  - Program requirements
- ACGME Staff:
  - Executive Director
  - Associate Executive Director
  - Senior Accreditation Administrator
  - Accreditation Administrator
  - Accreditation Assistant



#### RC Staff – call them as often as you need to



- Pay attention to details
  - Ask if you do not understand
- Pay attention to closing dates
- Submit an application that really shows us what your program is all about

- Initial Accreditation
- Continued accreditation
- Continued accreditation without outcomes
- Continued accreditation with warning
- Probationary accreditation
- Withdrawal accreditation
- (Administrative withdrawal) rare
- (Egregious violation) rare


