We need your help strengthening our recruitment efforts for “REACH”



Two weeks left to apply for REACH Cohort 3!

"REACH" (**R**ecognizing and **E**liminating disparities in **A**ddiction through **C**ulturally-Informed **H**ealthcare) is an initiative funded by SAMHSA with a two-fold mission: (1) Increase the overall number of racial/ethnic under-represented minority (URM) addiction providers in the workforce, and (2) Increase the number of URM addiction providers trained to work with URM patients with substance use disorders (SUDs).

We are looking to recruit 17 scholars total; 10 addiction fellows and 12 trainees (medical students, APRN/NP students, PA Students, and medical residents - all specialties).

Recruitment is only open to under-represented minority applicants (i.e. American Indian, Alaskan Native, Black, African, African-American, Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander, Hispanic or Latinx). **The application will close AUGUST 15, 2020.**
